4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 101 of Title 80, unless there is
7	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
8	The Legislature may review any executive order issued by the
9	President of the United States, federal agency rule or federal
10	congressional action to determine the constitutionality of the
11	order, rule or action. Upon recommendation from the Legislature,
12	the Attorney General of this state shall review the order, rule or
13	action by the federal government to determine the constitutionality
14	of the order, rule or action and whether the state should seek an
